The woodland flowers are blooming here in Prospect. Our Hepatica Hollow (below, photo: A. Harbord) is full of white, pale blue and darker blue Hepatica. The Coltsfoot appears around our property in a new spot every day. Bloodroot is starting to appear. The Crocus and Snowdrops have finished their blooms and now the Daffodils are ready to bloom, with the Scilla and Puschkinia (left, photo: De Vroomen) popping up in many beds. The fruit trees have been pruned and received their dormant oil spray. The fruit bushes and roses are nearly finished their Spring pruning ready to

receive their dormant oil spray once this series of rain-storms stop. It is so wonderful to be back in the garden and getting summer bulbs ready in pots, watching the Rhubarb shoot up more every day and praying that the foraged Asparagus will appear this year.

#### 4. CWF - CITY NATURE CHALLENGE – April 26 through 29



The Canadian Wildlife Federation invites Canadians from coast to coast to join the biggest international biodiversity tracking event of the year! It's super easy to take part in the 2024 City Nature Challenge! The City Nature Challenge involves people in over 50 countries and more than 600 cities around the world (including multiple Canadian cities from coast to coast).

Anyone in a participating city can use the free <u>iNaturalist app</u> to make observations of all the wild flora and fauna they can find — from the tiniest insect to mosses and fungi to birds, mammals, trees and more. It's a great way to explore nature while contributing to both an active scientific database and to Canada's total number of wildlife observations, as we compete against the world in tracking biodiversity.
